Eligibility Criteria

i. Master's Degree Holders

i. A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

ii. Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically

Duration of Ph.D. Programme

The Ph.D. Programme shall be:

- **Minimum Duration:** 3 Years (including coursework)
- **Maximum Duration:** 6 Years

- Publications (if any)
- Work experience certificates
- Research/professional experience documents
- No Objection Certificate (NOC), wherever applicable

Incomplete applications shall be rejected.

Admission Procedure

Admission to the Ph.D. Programme shall be based on:

1. Entrance Test
2. Personal Interview

Eligible candidates shall appear for the entrance examination on the notified date and time. Shortlisted candidates shall subsequently appear before an expert panel for personal interaction to assess their research aptitude and proposed research area.

Section A – Research Methodology & Aptitude (50% Weightage)

- Research Aptitude
- General Awareness
- Logical Reasoning
- Analytical Reasoning
- Numerical Ability
- English Language
- Statistics





Section B – Subject Specific (50% Weightage)

- As per UGC/CSIR-NET Syllabus

Important Instructions

1. The Entrance Test shall be qualifying in nature with minimum qualifying marks of **50%**.
2. Final merit shall be prepared based on:
 - **70% weightage** of Entrance Test marks
 - **30% weightage** of Interview marks

Candidates having UGC-NET (with JRF), UGC-CSIR NET (with JRF), Teacher Fellowship, Government/Foreign Research Fellowship, M.Phil. Degree with coursework (as per UGC Regulations 2009 or amended thereafter) shall be **exempted from the Entrance Test**, but must appear in the Interview.

3. Interview evaluation shall be based on:

Criteria	Marks
Competence for Proposed Research	10
Feasibility/Suitability of Research Plan	10
Novelty of Research Plan	10

Competence for proposed research

refers to whether the **researcher** has the **ability, knowledge, and resources** needed to successfully carry out the research plan.

Feasibility/suitability of plan

A plan is about whether the plan can **actually work** and whether it is **appropriate for the situation**.

Novelty of plan

How **new, original, or different** the plan is compared to existing ideas or standard approaches.
